SUBJECT: **DOCUMENTS EXPOSING IPCC FALSITIES**

Senator Wong:

On Friday, July 31 I sent you a letter accompanied by four (4) powerful documents written by John McLean. The package was mailed through Australia Post using its Registered Post service involving, at an extra fee, confirmation of receipt of the package by the addressee.

At the same time a similar package was sent to the Prime Minister using the same Australia Post Registered Post service. I subsequently received signed confirmation that the package was received by the Prime Minister's office on Tuesday, August 4th, 2009.

A similar package was sent to the Leader of the Opposition on Tuesday, August 4th using the same Australia Post Registered Post service. I received signed confirmation that the package was received by the office of the Leader of the Opposition on Thursday, August 6th, 2009.

Yet I have still not received confirmation the package addressed to you was received by your office. On Wednesday, August 19th, 2009 I telephoned Australia Post to trace my package addressed to you. An Australia Post consultant advised, by checking with the Parliament House Post Office that the package was still in the Parliament House Post Office awaiting collection by your office. In an aside from the consultant, I was advised that another package had been waiting seven (7) weeks since your office had been notified that package was awaiting collection by your office.

I consider the documents to be vitally important to Australia's environmental and economic security.

For that reason my letter and the most succinct of McLean's documents accompanies by facsimile.

I encourage and please request you read McLean's document which is beyond refutation since it simply presents IPCC data provided by the IPCC itself. I request that your office please collect my package from the Parliament House Post Office and that you carefully read McLean's documents and study the colour chart I provided. I remain available to answer your questions.
