

Senator Wong:

One week ago your office was notified by facsimile of a package waiting in the Parliament House Post Office since Tuesday, August 4th, 2009 for your office's collection. I have still not received confirmation your office staff have strolled over to collect the package. It's now one (1) month since the package was sent to you by Registered Post on July 31st, 2009.

The apparent disorganisation or neglect in your office is concerning. I hope that does not reflect the Minister's approach. Could you please advise why you will not collect the package or acknowledge receipt of my facsimiles?

I will be pleased to provide additional scientific references for your office and provide the names of solid and internationally eminent scientists with whom you could seek advice as an alternative to the discredited IPCC.
