The core solution is freedom through true forgiveness enabling consciousness of the core issue as a basis for taking action to protect people's freedom, wealth and security.

Look around. We live in a universe that's inherently abundant, wealthy, creative and wise. Appendix 17 revealed how we separate our Self from that abundance and power. We can return ourselves to that power and abundance.

Many fine Aussies gave their lives that we may enjoy freedom. 113 years ago many fine minds among Australia's founding fathers scoured many nations' constitutions to write what is arguably the world's best national constitution. These people and millions of honest citizens have served our country that it may have a bright, prosperous and peaceful future. We owe it to them and especially to our children and ourselves to restore Australia's potential.

Government of some form is necessary. Its fundamental duty is to protect life and protect property. How though can government control by the ego be minimised?

Given the human condition, there are three broad alternative forms of government:

- **Dictatorship.** In this form human ego can run rampant in the sole ruler. Nonetheless, history has thrown forward benevolent dictators under whose rule people have thrived. Yet even benevolent dictatorships end when dictators die. This form of government is risky. Additionally, devoid of decision-making, people lack responsibility. Dependency increases. In today's complex world bureaucrats would mean a transformation to mob rule or arbitrary control of the many by the few;
- **Rule by mob.** History reveals this to be extremely dangerous for two reasons: mobs are easily incited to murderous behaviour extending the ego's propensity for control. Secondly mobs are easily manipulated by the deceitful into acquiescence as demonstrated by UN manipulation of its conferences programmed to produce predetermined outcomes. The twentieth century confirmed that mobs can be emotionally hijacked and easily led to committing barbarous acts. Across nations mobs killed tens of millions of people. A 'civilised' version of mob rule exists in modern parliamentary democracy. Australia's current federal Lib-Lab caucuses demonstrate this: the weakness of the mob is manipulated by powerbrokers to silence and steer the mob. Potential for the mob to behave irrationally is repeatedly demonstrated in the present parliament. It's rampant and especially so behind-the-scenes. Additionally, governments spawn more regulations that in turn require more regulations;
- **Millions of hearts and minds making independent decisions to meet universal human needs in an aggregated collective.** When people are free to make independent decisions free from government manipulation the aggregated collective of their decisions is an open and free market for information, goods and services. Experience and history reveal that humans inherently care. Our need to express our care is deeply and strongly motivated. My observations in many nations confirm this inherent care. It's reinforced by the work of Marshall Rosenberg in his book entitled *NonViolent Communication*. Informed people throughout history have subordinated their own physical interests for the greater good of humanity, society, other individuals, animals and the environment. See Appendix 14. In true open markets in the real world people make decisions free from government regulation of any kind. When Common law based on the Magna Carta enforces personal contracts (verbal or written) through juries of 12 peers personal responsibility is restored. Developing accountability restores initiative and stimulates progress. Markets then become far cleaner and more efficient than those manipulated for the last century by bureaucrats, dictators, and international bankers exercising hidden control.

Each regulation in a *legal* yet unlawful system is an opportunity for the unscrupulous to take advantage. The nature of courts removed from Common law based on the Magna Carta favours the dishonest and the conniving. Through regulations governments can entrench their vices and drive inefficient behaviour for many years after they're removed. As Appendix 14 reveals.

Existence of the Human Condition as revealed and discussed in Appendix 17 means that no system will be perfect. Existence of the Human Condition though reveals that open and free markets are the superior alternative because they minimise the opportunity to be controlled and manipulated. When truly open and free they contain inherent automatic checks and balances that minimise distortions by the Human Condition.

Government's core role is to protect life and property: defence, police and overview of the judiciary. Restoring common law would protect people. All other services currently provided wastefully by federal government could be arranged through companies or, where citizens decide, by state and regional governments.

Justice Robert H. Jackson of the U.S. Supreme Court Justice, said, quote: *"It is not the function of the government to keep the citizen from falling into error; it is the function of the citizen to keep the government from falling into error."*

In 1912, then future American president Woodrow Wilson said, quote: *"Liberty has never come from government! Liberty has come from the subjects of government. The history of liberty is the history of resistance!"*

President Thomas Jefferson said, quote: *"When injustice becomes law, resistance becomes duty."*

The most powerful forces are non-material and unseen: heat or electromagnetic energy, atomic and sub-atomic energy, creativity, attitudes, feelings, thoughts, love, care, responsibility, leadership, honesty, strength of character, ... freedom itself. These energise and drive the visible forces.

In free economies most people think and take responsibility. They do so because they have a stake and are heard. Governance then doesn't depend on a few bureaucrats. Creativity is the key to innovation and efficiency. Creativity is the key to minimising waste of resources with government being by far the largest waster of resources due to lack of accountability. Creativity minimises human impact on the natural environment. Freedom and Common law for protecting freedom are essential for maximising creativity to enable efficiency and for protecting the environment.

Restoring freedom by removing artificial control over people's lives will replace manipulated fear and guilt with reassurance and care. It does this through the reality of human nature and our inherent care for each other and our planet. We need to allow people to freely express care. Combined with constructive emotion our care will transform current debilitating apathy, anger and frustration into hope, energy and action. Nurtured by freedom, care can transform deceit into opportunity for a vastly better future for us all.

Currently in America and Australia, the people serve government. We need to restore government's true role of serving the people. Restoring national constitutions as the supreme driver of governance can do that. That was intended by the founding fathers

and subsequently enshrined in repeated referenda. The will of the people is in the constitution. Governance under the constitution needs to be restored.

(1) We want due process. We want governance consistent with our country's constitution.

(2) Instil direct democracy for political accountability and stability.

Instilling direct democracy via direct voting on issues and Citizens Initiated Referenda would ensure politicians are held accountable. It raises voters' responsibility and stimulates voters to be well informed.

The successful work of millions of citizens worldwide in defeating the UN's corrupt climate alarm fabrication shows that people have earned the right to have a say in running their lives free from bureaucrats and international bankers. Despite spending billions of taxpayer dollars and despite constant alarmist and emotive propaganda through media owned largely by governments and international bankers pushing global governance, the people did not buy the con.

(3) We must exit the corrupt UN immediately. As an agent for international bankers and with their many departments enmeshed it's inherently corrupt. The UN will always be corrupt due to its antihuman agenda working for international bankers and opposing the peoples of all nations.

Due to the Human Condition MPs in most democratic nations, including Australia and America find it difficult to contain their spending. Parliamentary systems drive horse-trading that becomes pork-barrelling. History reveals that income tax and other tax systems were designed and pushed by international bankers for their benefit.

For stability and security we need to simultaneously manage revenue AND expenditure.

(4) We need a simple transaction tax whose rate is determined and modified by voters in referenda. It would replace all other taxes and be levied by the states. States would then allocate funds per capita to the national government vastly shrunk in accordance with Australia's constitution. This is essential.

A transactions tax would lift the burden of funding from citizens and small business alone. Foreign corporations would then pay their fair share for the infrastructure they currently use for next-to-nothing.

Effective tax reform is not possible in isolation. It must be addressed concurrently with expenditure. Australians are sufficiently mature, responsible and generously caring that all categories of spending need to be approved by the people directly.

(5) Government expenditure to be capped by the people using direct democracy.

Limited government. Government needs to be limited by enabling the people to determine expenditure. That would curtail growth of leviathan government:

It's imperative that the urge of MPs to spend is removed. It's imperative that current systems designed to sloppily raise expenditure and lower accountability by hiding pork-barrelling are reversed to limit spending and raise accountability.

(6) Freedom of speech needs to be restored

(7) Regulations need to be cut drastically across the board to enable citizens to live freely and to drive creativity and improve environmental protection.

Restore free markets and freedom of speech to enable creativity to flourish. Creativity is humanity's greatest resource. It's the key to every resource and to efficiency in using resources. As explained in Appendix 14, humans create every resource. Nature merely gifts raw materials. Humans then determine whether or not the gifts become resources.

Diversity of opinion needs to be fostered by free association and not restricted by regulation that entrenches weakness.

(8) Restore honest money to replace fiat money as credit with no tangible backing and lacking inherent value. See Appendix 14.

(9) Liberate education from government control to enable creativity and responsibility to flourish and to improve teacher satisfaction and salaries

Education systems need to be transformed to meet universal human needs of students as they develop toward adulthood. The Montessori philosophy of education and the International Baccalaureate (IB) provide proven philosophy and structure guiding sound and highly effective classroom practice. More importantly, they guide teachers in supporting students' complete development. Freeing education would enable these and other systems to be implemented widely and to stimulate creativity to develop improved practices, systems and delivery.

Instead of continuing to use an education format pushed by the Rockefellers to produce factory fodder we would foster competition among schools to improve education. That would develop the greatest human resource: creativity together with vastly increased responsibility.

Montessori education, when properly implemented, is proven to develop inquisitiveness, creativity, orderliness and self-discipline, responsibility, an appreciation of Nature and diversity, respect for others and for Self, a love of learning and responsibility for one's learning, independence combined with an appreciation of teamwork, an appreciation for varied learning modes among children, ... inner and outer peace and an awareness of the grander Universe and our roles within.

Montessori is so remarkably successful because it's based on the developmental needs of students from birth to 24 years of age.

The International Baccalaureate (IB) system is similarly based on real world needs of adolescents. Combining Montessori and IB provides a rigorous, balanced education that develops students mentally, intellectually, emotionally, physically and spiritually.

Montessori and IB provide opportunities for teachers to enjoy and gain enormous satisfaction from helping students to learn. In Montessori environments teachers are nurtured, take greater interest and responsibility while growing and developing themselves. A return to the joy of teaching brings greater peace as teachers release conventional control to experience greater power in their Self and with their students. This replaces constant struggles within conventional dominance structures in which teachers are required to constantly exert control over students. In environments and systems aligned with human developmental needs teachers flourish and enjoy their inherent peace in tune with the universe. Life becomes simpler and easier.

Among the most significant challenge in implementation of such systems though is the inability of many school administrators and some teachers to relinquish control. They've never experienced the real power of power with students.

(10) Remove science from government control

We share appreciation for the natural universe in which we live. Honest science develops understanding of Nature and magnifies Nature's beauty and wonder. This report's appendices repeatedly reveal that honest science is important for freedom and for our way of life. Accurate and open science shapes our perception of humanity and of our Self. That shapes our conduct and our relationship with others. We can consciously choose to be miserable believing unfounded antihuman propaganda that humans are merely voracious bellies and irresponsible uncaring consumers of resources. Or we can rely on empirical data proving that humans are not merely consumers and have amazingly positive impacts on our planet. We can be filled with fear and guilt from eugenicists peddling unfounded guilt and shame or we can be at ease by understanding empirical data.

Science needs to be free from government control and manipulation. Human creativity is our greatest resource and needs to be free to express itself and to freely explore.

Government can provide arms length auditing. Yet given the significance of weather forecasting, users of a private equivalent of the Bureau of Meteorology would willingly pay for reassurance from a private auditing firm. Private weather forecasters are in demand overseas as a result of government weather bureaux being tarnished by pushing projections made from unvalidated computerised numerical models within systems assuming unfounded claims about human CO2. JD Power and Associates in America provide scrutiny of products and services across many American industries.

Use of properly trained independent statisticians is essential. Meteorological observations and weather forecasting needs to be separated from climate analysis. Funding of climate analysts currently depends on producing alarmist projections a century into the future. In this system analysts cannot be held accountable. Closer scrutiny would enable higher and clearer accountability.

(11) Australian industry needs to be supported through fair trade

Australia needs to dump and reject commitments under the Lima Declaration. We need to assess levels of direct and indirect protection inhibiting free trade among our competitors overseas. Although free trade is an admirable goal and promotes exchange of ideas and stimulates creativity, free trade needs to be fair and not at the expense of Australian jobs vulnerable in a tilted playing field favouring nations relying on protection.

Australian industries don't need special support. They merely need a fair go. Government needs to fulfil its fundamental role of protecting property.

(12) Allow ideas and people to emerge in response to our country's needs.

There are many topics needing renewal and restoration to operating in accordance with our constitution. Talent available in Aussies across our nation is more than sufficient to restore Australia. People simply need to be given a fair go and to be heard.

We need to end the mentality that politicians and bureaucrats have the answers. Instead of relying on 226 federal MPs entrapped in national parliamentary and party systems driving counterproductive behaviours I'll back 22 million free people across our nation.

Overcoming the Human Condition – (13), (14) and (15)

The ego's currency is fear and guilt driving shame and perceived weakness. We do that by identifying ourselves with our bodies, as our bodies. Yet our mind is not our body. Our perception of our self is independent of the body. It's of the mind. We can change that. We can end the pain of separation.

My veil separating my ego from my real Self is my delusional perceived identification that I am my body. "I" is a level of consciousness. It's not a reality.

We can be with our real Self by truly forgiving—ie, by ceasing the ego's value judgments. We then are with the Universe and automatically feel its love that is inherently part of us and logically extends throughout the Universe. It seems to be a quiet, deep stillness experienced in the heart. It's natural and part of the Universe and our real Self. Yet many years of being out of touch by perceiving through the ego's eyes ensures that initially it's not easy and it's fleeting. Gradually it becomes more frequent yet for me remains much less frequent than I'd like.

From what I've seen, our goal in life is to find and return to our real Self. To end the separation that arose from fabricating my ego, *I*.

At times it feels peaceful in various activities. Yet there is no peace except the peace of the Universe. True forgiveness returns us to the cusp of reality. The universe then selects its time to bring us Home to our real Self.

When we see with a forgiving mind we have vision. We see clearly. Freed from value judgments that are simply fabrications of what our mind perceives, we see reality.

Vision comes through forgiveness because only through true forgiveness can I see instead of perceiving my ego-driven, fear-filled delusions fabricated by my intellect. Without forgiveness I will still be blind.

When we look upon our brothers and sisters with forgiveness we see their loveliness and it reflects my own.

From *A Course In Miracles*, quote: "*Love is the way I walk in gratitude*".

(13) Give compassion to controllers. Giving compassion benefits the giver

The pain of people seeking to control others deserves our compassion. Giving compassion meets our own needs for connection and care. It is by giving that we receive providing our intent is sincerely to give and care.

(14) Celebrate and appreciate the reality about humanity and Nature

We can give another huge gift by restoring reality about humanity and Nature. We can use that to replace antihuman ideology infecting our schools, government and political parties. We can replace antihuman ideology in NGO's preying on guilt and shame to extract donations as guilt money. Instead, we need to celebrate humanity and appreciate our many gifts.

Let's replace Earth Day *celebrations* or combine it with a new celebration, People Day. Let's celebrate our species as the greatest species on Earth and one with all other species and the natural environment that emerged with us from the Universe. We're the only species that can become aware of and change its own actions based on understanding our impact on our host planet.

Appreciation is highly beneficial for us physically, emotionally, mentally and spiritually. It boosts our creativity. It triggers solutions to challenges.

(15) Forgive

An essential action is to forgive those seeking to control. True forgiveness is merely the removal of value judgment. Forgiving others delivers personal freedom and societal freedom to our self.

Forgiveness does not mean idly allowing the hurting of life or property. It simply means we approach the situation with a clear mind and heart. That enables us to bring our full Self to the situation rather than our limited self that's limited by ego driven fears and prejudices that increase separation and close off solution.

Forgiveness is often misunderstood. Consider four levels:

1. Punish the other person and then offer to pardon her/him. That's not true forgiveness, it's blame. It entrenches separation and pain for all;
2. Identify the other person's actions as transgressions and forgive them as lapses. Some could say that's arrogance. It perpetuates separation;
3. Identify the other person's actions as inherent weaknesses of being human. That separates us from our real Self, the self into which we were born and that is of the universe. It reinforces ego;
4. True forgiveness makes no value judgment about the other person because we all are doing the best that we can. This leads us gradually to return Home to our real Self, One with the universe of which we are a part. All people are our sister or brother.

True forgiveness ends control. It brings freedom. It creates lasting and deep peace. It's the only true peace since it is the universe's peace.

True forgiveness does not imply condoning everything. We still protect life and property. We change our intent though from punishment and fear to loving protection. The work of psychologists Marshall Rosenberg and Gene Gendlin reveal in their work on *NonViolent Communication* and *Focussing* respectively provides steps for returning return to our real Self, our *felt sense*, our essence. That returns us to our real power, the power of our Universe.

It's the most powerful force there is. Forgiveness is truly loving. It is love. It nurtures and builds responsibility. It enables choice.

Chinese philosopher Lao Tzu is quoted as saying: "*He who controls others may be powerful, but he who has mastered himself is mightier still.*"

Lao Tzu, quote: *“Being deeply loved by someone gives you strength, while loving someone deeply gives you courage.”*

Freed from value judgment of others we are freed from value judgment of our self. Our inherent care and our return to our real Self mean that we overrule or bypass our ego and its focus on punishment and fear. We start to end control of our self and others.

This doesn't usually occur overnight. Many of us struggle with the path to return Home to our real Self. It seems that is life's ultimate journey. It's about realising and then, more importantly experiencing our reality in being One with the universe. Enjoying real peace, universal peace.

It can be difficult for us raised in a society that programs us to blame and punish. We can thank our society though for without the punishment and blame that envelop us and cause us to hurt ourselves, we cannot appreciate our real Self.

Only a fish born and living in polluted water can appreciate the joy of entering pure water for the first time. Forgiveness helps us along our path from the polluted Human Condition in which we've fabricated our ego to glimpse and possibly one day remain in the Universe's reality.

Power based in control over others is debilitating. Removal of control returns us to our real self. It liberates our inherent care. Real power comes from declining to control. It bypasses the ego's delusory power. We tap the Universe's power. There is nothing more powerful.
